#### Introduction

#### **Format**

The main event at Thrill at the Hill 2025 is a single day 2 round tournament. There are prizes for the top players in each division (cash payouts for Pro divisions). Normal PDGA rules of play apply.

There is also an optional Glow Round taking place on Friday Oct 3rd. This is just for fun and prizes. Scores from this will not count towards the main event.

UDisc will be used for scoring all rounds. If you don't have a (free) UDisc account you'll need to create one prior to the tournament. We'll be reaching out to any players we can't locate on UDisc.

The first round is standard shotgun start.

The second round will be a hybrid shotgun start:

- Most cards will shotgun start as normal however select lead cards will sequentially start on Hole 1 in 10 minute intervals.
- Pay attention to your tee time and starting hole on UDisc, you may be teeing off on Hole 1 after the general shotgun start.

#### **Layouts & Divisions**

There are 3 different layouts in play at this year's tournament. Pay careful attention to which layout you are playing in each round as Tees, Baskets, Mandos, CTP Hole, and even Hazard/OB Rules may vary between different layouts.

All divisions will compete for the same CTPs. Morning winners will get a free hamburger lunch, afternoon winners will receive prizes.







Everything up to and including the first path is hazard. If your disc lands in hazard play from where it lies with a penalty stroke.







Triple Mando in effect: disc must pass between the left and right mando and below the upper mando. Missed mando proceed to the drop zone with a penalty stroke

Island Hole: Drive must come to rest inside the marked island.

If a drive does not come to rest in the island proceed to the drop zone with a penalty stroke.

For subsequent shots treat the perimeter of the island as an out of bounds line.





Wait for players on 16 to tee off before throwing approaches into the green.











#### **Appendix - Rules Clarifications**

This section is just intended as a reference to provide clarity and resolve any disputes about specific rules or interpretations of rules. This will likely not come into play for most players.

**Paths**: Paved paths and beyond are considered out of bounds on all holes and are normally marked on the hole layout. Dirt and gravel paths are not considered out of bounds unless otherwise specified on the hole layout. If a disc lands on or beyond a path outside the view of the hole map that would still be considered out of bounds. The out of bounds line is defined as the closest edge of the hard asphalt to the fairway; loose pieces of asphalt are not considered part of the OB area.

**Roads**: All paved roads and beyond are considered out of bounds and are normally marked on the hole layouts. If the road has a curb the edge of the curb closest to the fairway will be considered the OB line. If the road does not have a curb the hard edge of the pavement will be considered the OB line, loose pieces of asphalt are not considered part of the OB area.

#### **Appendix - Rules Clarifications**

**Sidewalks**: All sidewalks and beyond are considered out of bounds and the closest edge of the sidewalk to the fairway will be considered the OB line.

**Water**: All water in ponds, creeks, ditches, and other areas intended to contain water is considered out of bounds. If a disc comes to rest in any of these areas with water on all sides it shall be considered out of bounds. Reeds or other vegetation in the water are not in-bounds (IE: A disc in the water but leaning on reeds is still out of bounds). Dry areas of ponds, creeks, ditches, etc would be considered in bounds. Water in other areas (IE: puddles) is considered in bounds, play the disc where it lies.

**Private Property**: All back yards are out of bounds, the edge of the fence closest to the fairway is the out of bounds line.

**Failing to Cross In-Bounds**: Some tees are located in an out of bounds area, if a drive fails to cross in bounds at any point the player must re-tee with a penalty stroke unless otherwise indicated on the sign.

#### **Appendix - Rules Clarifications**

**Baseball Fields**: All baseball fields are out of bounds, the bottom edge of the chain link is the out of bounds line even if the fence is bent away from the poles.

**Mandatories**: For each mandatory the restricted plane is defined by the plane of the mandatory sign itself.

**Island**: The boundary of the Island hole is marked with a circle of wood chips as well as pink whiskers. The pink whiskers make up the official boundary line. To determine if a disc is in or out draw a straight line between the center of the two nearest pink whiskers.
