




Cash Flow Income

Minutes from Q3, 2025

Program activity this quarter

- Ran community programming and pop-up play with a focus on post-wildfire recovery and low-barrier participation.
- Hosted a free community disc-golf day at the Ski Hill (course built and removed within the season). Strong turnout and positive feedback.
- Supported a Grade 5 Culture Days clinic with the Flin Flon School Division.
- Partnered with Bridge City Discs at the **Thrill at the Hill 2025** tournament in Martensville, strengthening provincial relationships.
- Sponsors were acknowledged on signage/social posts throughout the quarter.

Grants, sponsorships, and in-kind

- External support included SPRA (\$3,500) and SaskEnergy (\$500) earlier in the year. All restricted funds carried into Q3 were fully utilized by quarter-end.
- In-kind items (e.g., pizzas, prizes, drinks/snacks, pool passes) received in prior periods were distributed this quarter and expensed when used.

Depreciation

Capital assets are depreciated on a straight-line basis. **Baskets depreciation for the quarter: \$86.34** (non-cash). Accumulated depreciation was updated accordingly.

Summary

Q3 focused on delivering accessible, no-cost recreation as communities stabilized after the wildfire season. With all restricted funds utilized. The organization remains on mission, building participation and partnerships for 2026.
